PARKING

A five-story, 2,400 car parking garage provides covered long- and short-term parking and a heated pedestrian bridge, which takes travelers directly to the security checkpoint in the terminal. Short-term parking, free for the first 30 minutes, is located on the first floor of the parking garage and in front of the terminal. Garage parking is located on floors two, three, four and five, while long-term parking is located in a lot surrounding the garage in front of the terminal. The Airport also features an economy lot to the east of the terminal, which is serviced by a free shuttle bus.

HOTEL SHUTTLES

A number of area hotels provide transportation to and from the Airport. A complete list of hotels and direct phones for reservations and transportation can be found at the Reservation Center located in the baggage claim area on the first floor of the terminal.

TAXI/LIMOUSINE SERVICE
